How to Build a **TREASURE CHEST**

You won't find pieces-of-eight or old gems in this modern treasure chest by International Harvester.

But under that big 5 ft. door you can store a king's ransom in table delicacies . . . 15 cubic ft. of garden magic and choice meat cuts.

That freezer door is a Minster press stamping. In fact, the four series 50 Minster presses you see here produce doors and bin fronts for all International

Harvester freezer and refrigerator models.

First press on the right is a 400 ton Minster used for drawing at 12 strokes per minute. The others do the return flange work and trimming at 14 strokes per minute. And when crisper pans (14" x 8" x 5") are being run, approximately 350 per hour are drawn from 19 gauge enameling iron.
